Fees Per Golfer – **\$85:** For TΦΔ Alumni and guests **\$60:** For TΦΔ Active Brothers and students

Skill Contests – Includes closest to pins, longest drive, a hole-in-one contest (With a prize of a new four-wheeler ATV), prizes for the winning team, a 50/50 drawing, and much more!

Rules –

- Must have your own set of clubs – No sharing clubs!
